The Southwestern Environmental Education Exchange - Privacy Policy

The Southwestern Environmental Education Exchange (E3) is committed to protecting your privacy online. This Privacy Policy explains how we treat your personal information when you visit this website, which is operated by the E3. This Privacy Policy applies to this website and the E3's websites www.eeexchange.org and www.e3learn.org and to all associated subdomains (each a "Site"), you are advised to consult the "Privacy" link on the Site each time you visit these Sites. By visiting any of the Sites, you are accepting the practices described in this Privacy Policy. If you disagree with any of the terms herein, please immediately discontinue use of the Sites.

By using, browsing, or accessing the Sites, you agree to be bound by this Privacy Policy, as in effect at the time of your access.

The Information We Collect or What Information We Collect

We may collect, store and use the following kinds of personal information:

- information that you provide to us when registering with the Site (including your email address and phone number);
- information about your computer and about your visits to and use of this website (including your IP address, approximate geographical location, browser type and version, operating system, referral source, length of visit, page views and website navigation paths);
- information that you provide to us when using the services on the Site, or that is generated in the course of the use of those services (including the timing, frequency and pattern of service use);
- information contained in or relating to any communication that you send to us or send through the Site (including the communication content associated with the communication); and any other personal information that you choose to send to us.

Cookies

The sites uses cookies to remember certain information about users. Cookies are electronic identifiers that our server sends to your web browser. Your web browser stores these identifiers and sends them back to our server when your browser requests a page from the server. The cookies stored in your browser help us provide a better experience of the Sites by showing us how users are interacting with the Sites and to remove the need to login to do multiple actions on the website.

You may at any time disable or refuse to accept cookies by changing the preferences or settings on your web browser. If you choose to disable cookies you will still be able to use the Site. However you may not be able to use all features of the website if you disable or refuse to accept cookies.

How We Protect Your Personal Information

E3 is committed to protecting the information you provide to us. We employ multiple layers of physical, technical and administrative controls, including firewalls, anti-virus software and encryption technology, to protect the availability, confidentiality and integrity of our systems and the information stored there. E3 uses the Google platform (Google Docs, Google Sheets) to store website visitors' data and further downloads data for storage on secure Dropbox servers. Access to our systems for staff and, when appropriate, volunteers is permission-based and access to personal information is restricted. But no data transmission or storage system is 100 percent secure from unauthorized access or use.
